



APPLETON SAFE RIDE PROGRAM

Objective & Outcome

In Wisconsin, someone is injured or killed in an alcohol-related crash every three hours. In 2020, alcohol accounted for 6,050 crashes killing 167 people, which is 25% of all traffic fatalities that year. Our Leadership Fox Cities group seeks to reduce these numbers by raising funds to be able to provide a safe alternative to those who would have otherwise driven home while intoxicated on New Year's Eve.

We have partnered with Fox Valley Cab who generously offered to dedicate three drivers for a flat fee that will be covered by our program so there will be no cost to the riders. Appleton Downtown Inc. is also partnering with us to help promote the program, and in future years to keep it alive so it will be an annual offering. Our research indicates that our Safe Ride program will take approximately 100 impaired drivers off of our local streets in the first year alone, and that this number will likely increase over time as awareness of the program grows year over year.

Objective & Outcome

Project Pen Pal has been a wonderful project where we have connected Fox Valley's elderly population with the Fox Valley's budding elementary writers. Back in September, as a team, we recognized that due to the pandemic, one of the most vulnerable populations had lost connection with the outside world.

We connected Freedom Elementary classrooms & Clovis Elementary Classrooms with assisted living and nursing home facilities in the area where they have written and shared letters and artwork back and forth.

Objective & Outcome

As a result of the COVID-19 Pandemic, we have seen a significant rise in mental health issues among children, teenagers, and young adults. Many parents and caregivers are faced with these issues, and find themselves searching for the help that their loved ones need. To address this need, we partnered with Rawhide Youth Services. Rawhide has an established reputation as one of the elite mental health care providers in the state, but with their recent rebranding, were in need of bringing that brand awareness to the communities they serve. Our objective was to create a business card with a QR code that would link to a newly designed Rawhide Youth Services landing page. As brand ambassadors, our team will assist in the distribution of these cards to area law enforcement, fire departments, EMS, school guidance offices, and other community locations. The goal is to be able to hand these cards to someone looking for assistance in locating appropriate mental health resources. Additionally, mental health agencies share ideas that can grow to create more mental health resource awareness beyond Rawhide Youth Services.

Objective & Outcome

Our group took on a research/consultative role to help Imagine Fox Cities explore inclusive ways to welcome newcomers to the Fox Cities area while promoting a sense of belonging, especially among those with historically marginalized identities. Research questions included: What can we learn from other communities who have successfully built inclusive welcoming programs? What resources for best practices exist? And finally, who could be potential community partners in this work? We were able to produce a report and presentation that is not only being presented to Imagine Fox Cities, but also to New North's Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging Community Workstream group. Our group's work helped inform a plan of action for Imagine Fox Cities that includes potential partner outreach and focus groups with community members.

Objective & Outcome

Over 10 Appleton Area School District students have taken part in the process of assembling and staining the little libraries. We have solidified commitment to host the little libraries from 2 area low-income apartment complexes and a non-profit:

- Woodland Meadows in Menasha home to approximately 60 children
- Another in Neenah home to over 40 children
- Harbor House in Appleton 68 beds in facility to accommodate women and children

All three communities' respective libraries have made commitments to fill the libraries on a continual basis to improve literacy in low-income areas. Obtained a Thrivent team action grant, and a company donation to hand out goodie bags with healthy snacks, a small toy, and hygiene products catered to the kids within the communities.
