Objective

To develop a business case and playbook that is a working tool to be used as a catalyst for rooftop development in the Fox Cities. The intention is to bring the use of rooftop space to the forefront of building and business owners as not only an additional revenue opportunity, but to provide the residents and guests of the Fox Cities with a way to enjoy the beautiful communities we live in from a vantage point not experienced before. Our warm weather season is limited to only a few months of the year. By providing more outdoor entertainment space, it's a way to take advantage of that weather and the city landscape and skyline we have to offer, while still preserving the historical feel of downtown and utilizing existing real estate available. The playbook is designed to be a guide that outlines considerations for having a rooftop venue: what the rooftop can be used for, why is it a viable option, how to begin the process of creating a rooftop space, who to contact for assistance, and what options and requirements are necessary for a rooftop to be functional. The playbook also provides contact information of resources in the community and outlined information of the various phases of the project based upon actual examples of buildings toured in downtown Appleton.

Outcome & Impact

We are hopeful that what transpires is for rooftop space to be considered relevant and practical going forward to reach members of the communities in a way that hasn't been done previously. That it's something the community rallies behind and is not only a usable space developed on existing buildings but is a consideration when constructing new buildings. We have many great events each year in the Fox Cities. Take downtown Appleton for example. The Mile of Music, annual celebratory parades, Music in the Park, Mini golf on the Town, Farmer's Market and Octoberfest just to name a few. Now imagine participating in all these events from a rooftop. Other options can entail, painting or yoga classes, green space, business meetings, dining, or perhaps enjoying a beverage or two on a beautiful day. We see the attraction that rooftop venues have become in other cities within Wisconsin and throughout the country. As we continue to look for way to innovate and retain residents, along with attracting more residents, rooftop venues are a great way to do this.

Objective

To create a safe physical space inside Appleton East High School where students can go to take time for a mental, emotional, or physical health break during their school day. The renovation includes new furniture, fixtures, and wall and floor treatments focused on enhancing the physical and mental health of students.

Outcome & Impact

According to the Fox Cities LIFE Study 2016, twelve percent of high school students in the Fox Cities attempted suicide in the past year. Through our own research and meetings, our group learned that at Appleton East High School there have been over 1,100 documented counselor office visits and a 15% increase of mental health hospitalizations this year alone. To cope with challenges, students often retreat to the bathroom, skip classes, or leave campus without seeking resources offered by the school. By creating a safe and stigma free space, we hope students choose to seek help and support within in the walls of the school instead of struggling alone.

We would like to thank Theresa Lehman and the entire team at Miron Construction, Appleton East High School, Principal Matt Mineau, Associate Principal Alex Molitor and the student group Sources of Strength, without their generous support our project would still be an idea on paper. We never imagined our desire to help kids would turn into a project impacting thousands of students for years to come.

Objective

Outcome & Impact

Our partnership will result in a sustainable marketing tool for United Way's 2-1-1 that can be used over the next several years and potentially reach thousands of high schoolers. Five 30 second PSAs were created and 2 finalists will be selected. Those 2 PSAs will be shared via social media by the students themselves as part of the voting process. The winning PSA, selected by a committee of judges and taking into account the social media vote, will be featured on WBAY-TV2 for several months. The PSA will first premier on the news, along with a possible interview of the winning students. Both finalist videos will be shown in Fox Cities' high schools for years to come to continue to increase awareness of United Way's 2-1-1.
