Objective

Create connections and a sense of belonging within our community.

Outcome & Impact

Due to COVID-19, we had to cancel our original project, "Creating Connections Across Fox Cities," an evening event to drive connections between community members and cultivate a stronger sense of belonging in the Fox Cities. We found a new event that we could support that still embraced our original goal of bringing a strong sense of belonging in our community. Our group was able to successfully promote and increase attendance for the Imagine Fox Cities virtual event "A Convening on Anti-Racism, Belonging, & Community." We created and executed a marketing campaign to drive awareness and excitement about the event and the important topics that were discussed. We maximized the community presence of the Imagine Fox Cities team to market the event and utilized our own personal, social, and professional connections to reach a wider audience and increase attendance. Through our efforts, we had 868 people register for the event. Facebook followers for Imagine Fox Cities increased from 916 to 1,007 from the time period of August 1, 2020, to August 23, 2020, and posts that were shared by us regarding the event reached more than 3,600 people.

Objective

Our goal was to partner with Ruby's Pantry to raise the funds needed to provide food shares to our local community at no cost for the month.

Outcome & Impact

Our Leadership Fox Cities team came together with the hope of finding a way to support the Fox Cities during Wisconsin's Safer at Home Order. As we learned more about Ruby's Pantry, we were enthusiastic about the organization's mission! Ruby's Pantry is a local organization that gathers and distributes corporate surplus food and goods to those within our community. While monthly food shares from Ruby's Pantry generally cost \$20/share, our goal was to raise the \$8,000 needed to cover all food shares for Ruby's Pantry for the month. With the generous support from our community and local corporate sponsors such as U.S. Venture, Menasha Corporation Foundation and ThedaCare, we were able to reach our goal and offer food shares to our local community from Ruby's Pantry at no cost for the month of May!

Objective

Our team wanted to make an impact on children within the Fox Cities somehow. Through our connections, we met Pastor Mahnie, Executive Director of the nonprofit B.A.B.E.S. Child Abuse Prevention Program. We realized this group could benefit from and was welcome to the idea of collaborating together on our journey.

Outcome & Impact

After brainstorming as a group and with Pastor Mahnie on what the non-profit organization needed to advance their mission, our initial plan was to help provide updates to their building by raising funds and recruiting volunteers. Rebuilding Together Fox Valley agreed to partner with us to combine resources to make this happen. As conversations continued, other potential opportunities for both organizations became available and the LFC team decided to go in a different direction by hosting a family-friendly fundraising event in April. Just as items were finalized to begin to advertise, gain sponsors and encourage attendance, COVID-19 caused the temporary pause of events at our facility and events in general. As a result, the event was postponed and eventually cancelled. During the COVID-19 shutdown, Pastor Mahnie continued to share with the LFC team updates on how her team was working with their families in different ways than before. The group decided to take on a virtual fundraising effort with our connections and on social media to raise needed funds for B.A.B.E.S. to continue to offer no-cost programs and services to young families. With pro-bono work from Bard Media, the team was able to put together short videos to share on our social media platforms and promote our month long fundraiser. The campaign concluded with us exceeding our monetary goal of \$10,000, but more importantly we also helped bring awareness to the community on what a great resource B.A.B.E.S. is for many families in the community.
