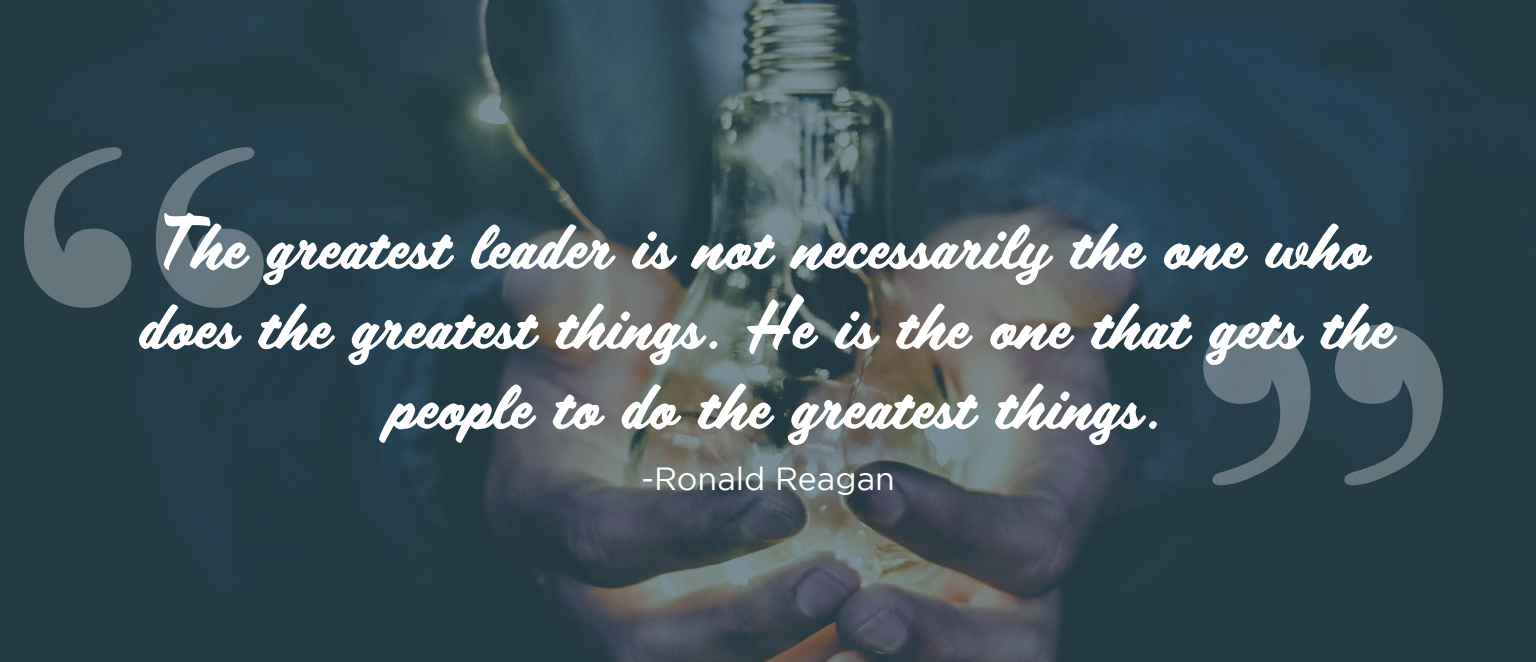

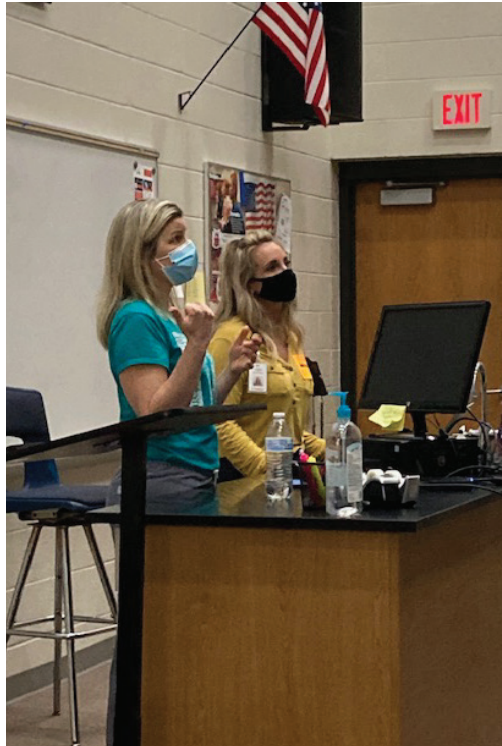
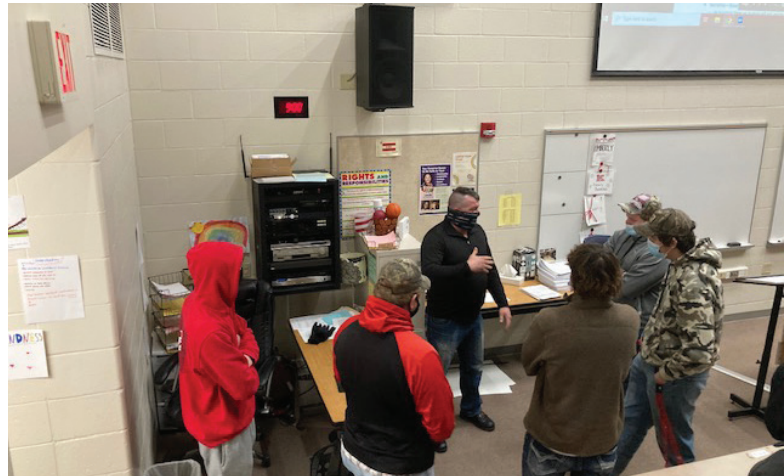

Objective & Outcome

Working with the Neenah Police Department, this project was focused on perceptions of law enforcement throughout our community, ultimately working to create “Cast with a Cop,” a community event allowing children and families in the Neenah area to go fishing with police officers, see them on a human level, and gain understanding of the role the officers play. In addition, the event will feature multiple education exhibits and provide children with free fishing equipment. Activities for adults will be provided, too!

Objective & Outcome

This project engaged more than 100 Kimberly High School students as a pilot for future LFC high school outreach. A successful template was created for a career-based mentorship program, including opportunities for future talent to engage with professionals in government, health care, banking, higher education, construction, and nonprofit work. Presentations featured more than 25 specific careers with a wide variety of associated education requirements and were followed up with small-group breakout sessions for networking and further exploration.

VITAL PROGRAM

Objective & Outcome

This project saw Leadership Fox Cities team up with VITAL, a volunteer-based tutoring program at Lawrence University, to help expand and enrich the services provided – as well as address a waitlist for services by recruiting more tutors into the program. The project participants created new resources in math and literacy, made training material enhancements, and explored a number of avenues for expanding VITAL’s pool of potential tutors, including corporate partnerships and working to create a database of retired teachers in the Fox Cities region.

Objective & Outcome

Making outdoor gatherings more plentiful and pleasant during Wisconsin winters was the goal of this project, which leveraged a partnership with the Appleton Parks and Recreation Department to recommend enhancements to Fox Cities outdoor gathering spaces and outdoor recreation programs. Specifically, “Wintermission” was successful in creating a campaign to solicit donations for ice skates to create a rental program in Appleton.

READY READERS FOX CITIES

Objective & Outcome

This project raised \$3,455 to purchase more than 2,500 books for Fox Cities children. With fewer children in schools or visiting libraries during COVID-19, providing a different route to get books into homes was deemed vital to maintain levels of school readiness and promote future reading skills. The books were distributed via five area nonprofit organizations with youth-based missions, as well as to 10 schools in the Neenah Joint School District and to the Appleton Area School District’s early childhood program. Titles were offered both in English and other languages, ultimately getting into the hands of 2,500 children who will also likely pass the books on to others, creating “ready readers” across our community.
