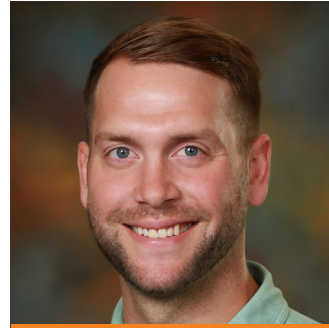

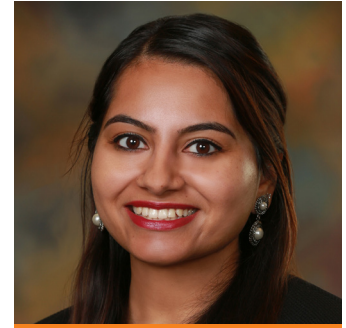

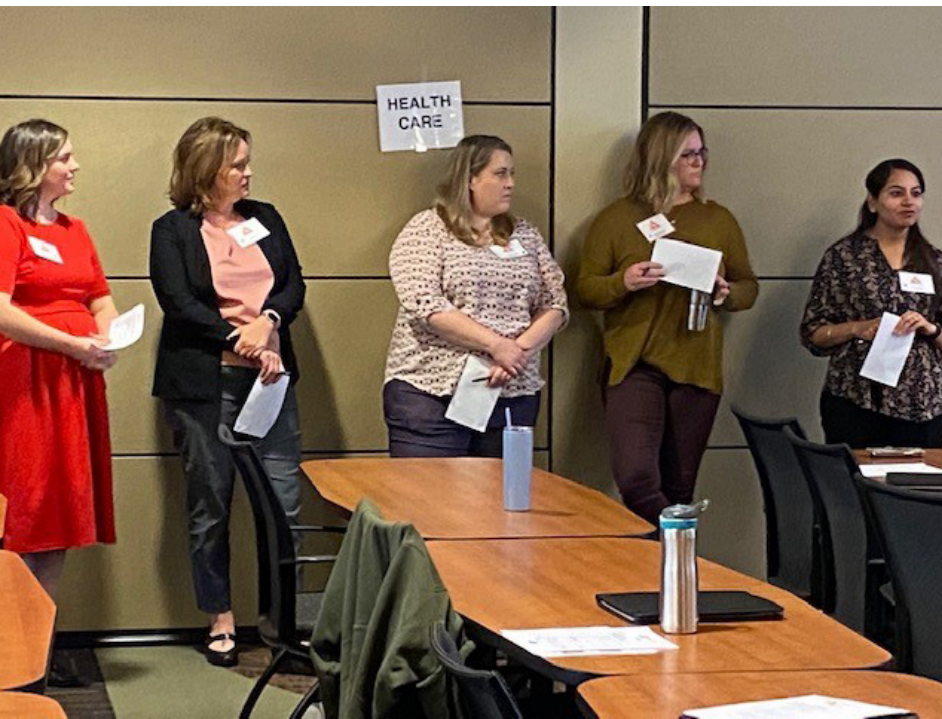

## PITCH-IN KITCHEN

### Objective & Outcome

The Pitch-In Kitchen allowed 14 Horizon Elementary School students to immerse themselves in a live kitchen at Appleton East with guidance from a culinary arts teacher and 11 high school student leaders. In this pilot program, students created an easy-to-make meal, encouraging students to develop math skills and culinary confidence. Each participant toured the hydroponics lab, learned about cooking techniques and tools as well as food safety. While preparing meals, students reserved a portion of their servings to donate to COTS of Appleton. Upon the conclusion of the session, students took home the meal they crafted to feed their own families, a set of recipe cards, an apron, and a sprout.

With exceptional feedback from all participants and supervisors, we hope to see Pitch-In Kitchen continue to expose students to cultural foods, develop skills-based recipes, provide mentorship opportunities between high school and elementary students, and additional opportunities to support the community with the meals they prepare.

### Objective & Outcome

Since COVID-19, the Fox Cities has experienced an increased number of people facing homelessness. Pillars Adult Shelter houses roughly 20-30 individuals at any given time who are ready and able to work but struggling to find gainful employment, due to gaps in work history.

HireUp aims to fight homelessness by connecting Pillars residents to direct hire, long-term, financially sustainable employment opportunities that also provide full benefits. We believe that these opportunities will allow residents to transition out of the shelter and into long-term, market-rate housing.

In order to make our goal a reality, we are hoping to partner with 2-3 local businesses that are struggling to recruit and retain talent. Aligning willing and able-bodied people with available positions fills employment gaps for our business partner. Pillars Case Managers support residents along the way. Successful transitions open shelter beds up to those on an increasingly long waitlist, while also providing a continuous introduction of new applicants to our business partners.

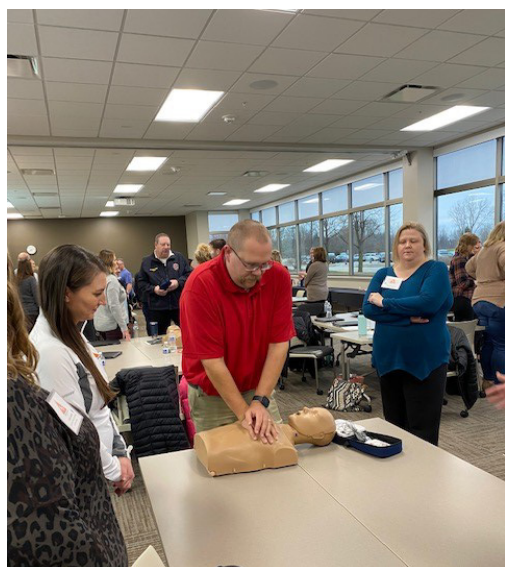
#### Objective & Outcome
