







2023-25 budget has huge surplus




STATE RESERVES Have grown




Spending would rise 18% in year one

Appropriations from all revenue sources by year in billions (nominal dollars)




Funds go to several priorities




Bill would add 800+ positions

Proposed change in all state FTE positions, 2023-25




Tax cuts, increases cancel out




Income tax plans compared

Amount of total income tax change compared to current law by income* class of tax filer




Current Taxes owed by filer group




Spending would exceed revenues




How high should reserves be kept?


State aid to locals would rise


K-12 funding would get big boost

State special education aid to schools (dark blue) and reimbursement rate (light blue), 2000-01 to 2024-25*




Early childhood Education plans


The governor's plan would:

- Use primarily state dollars to continue the pandemic-era Child Care Counts program (\$81M in GPR in 2024 and \$221M in 2025 plus \$19M in federal TANF funds in each year)
- Create an \$11.2M a year program to establish partnerships between businesses, workers, and child-care providers
- Provide \$5M in TANF each year for a New Provider grant to help increase the supply of child-care providers
