Membership in the Chamber or participation in Chamber activities constitutes your consent to abide by this Code of Conduct. Violation of this Code of Conduct may result in expulsion from the Chamber or any activity, suspension or non-renewal of membership, or other legal or administrative action as the Chamber deems appropriate.

Termination of Membership:

Any Chamber member may be expelled from membership for conduct or business practices deemed detrimental to the purposes of the Chamber. Expulsion from the Chamber is at the discretion of the Chamber CEO and Chamber Executive Committee. No refund of dues or fees will be made to any member so expelled.
