



















CONNECTING THROUGH SERVICE

ENRICHING YOUTH AREAS AND PROGRAMS AT HARBOR HOUSE

Objective & Outcome

The goal of our project was to enhance and enrich the youth areas and programs at the center, with a focus on creating a safe, supportive, and empowering environment for children and teenagers affected by domestic and sexual abuse. We created welcoming, child-friendly spaces within the center where young people feel secure, valued, and comfortable seeking help and support.

We revamped three areas at Harbor House.

- 1. Interactive Mural Wall By transforming a mundane cream-colored wall into an engaging focal point, we infused a popular walk area with vibrancy and interaction. A calming blue hue now envelops the space, inviting guests to pause and engage. Interactive elements such as phrases prompting actions like "jump," "spin," and "trace it," alongside captivating imagery and uplifting quotes, create an immersive experience that ignites curiosity and joy, enriching the atmosphere with energy and inspiration.
- **2. Calm Down Corner** To create a more soothing environment, we introduced a calming corner enriched with interactive wall art, comfortable seating, and subtle pops of color. The interactive wall art engages guests, providing a dynamic focal point that encourages relaxation and reflection. Plush seating invites individuals to unwind, while the carefully curated color palette fosters a serene atmosphere, promoting a sense of tranquility and well-being within the space.
- **3. Teen Room** Revamping the teen room, we tailored the space to cater to study and leisure. We ensured versatility by introducing a sleek desk for focused study sessions and vibrant gaming chairs for immersive entertainment. With a playful touch, a fun light illuminates the room, while a new TV offers enhanced viewing experiences. A pop of color injects personality, completing the dynamic ambiance and fostering a space where teens can thrive academically and unwind comfortably.



THE WELCOME HOME PROJECT

Objective & Outcome

In Outagamie County, one out of every five foster youth aging out of the system are living and facing homelessness. The Appleton Housing Authority recently received a HUD grant for 25 Foster Youth to Independence vouchers to help subsidize rent and utilities for qualifying foster youth aging out of the system.

The Welcome Home Project is a partnership with the Appleton Housing Authority and Neighborhood Housing Inc. to raise funds to assemble "Welcome Home" basic needs starter kits for Foster Youth moving into their very first apartment. Essentials include things like a bed, dishware, bedding, linens, silverware, cleaning supplies, and so much more! Upon moving in we want them to be greeted with "The Welcome Home Project" starter kit, showing them that their community supports them and this is their time to shine!

Our goal was to procure 25 kits, which required us to raise \$22,000. We have already raised just over \$13,000, which will give us an opportunity to deliver 15 of the 25 kits. We were able to raise these funds through several individual cash donors, Amazon wish list donors, corporate sponsors, and community donors. We were able to deliver our first Welcome Home starter kit and are looking forward to delivering the next set of kits to those searching for their very own apartment. Our team hopes to continue this program beyond just 25 vouchers in 2024!
