





SMALL GROUP PROJECTS



GROUP #1 - YOUTHGO FORWARD

Objective & Outcome

We chose to partner with YouthGo, a children's drop-in center for Grades 5-12 in Neenah/Menasha. Our goal was to find a way to make a lasting impact for both the children that attend the facility and the staff that work there. We did this by first touring YouthGo with their director to understand what needs they had for the facility. One of the items we discovered during our tour was the back door of the building, which was in need of being replaced for security purposes. Additionally, we determined that their front welcome desk and floor in the entryway could use some repairs. Lastly, we learned that their back lot needed to be repainted and they were looking for more outdoors games for the children during the warmer seasons. All of these projects were intended to provide a safer and more updated facility for the children and staff.

To achieve these goals we started fund raising with the goal of accomplishing as many of these facelift projects as we could. To date we have been able to provide funding to replace the door and have a new desk built. We worked with the Menasha High School wood shop class where the students built the front desk that will be installed at YouthGo. We have also raised enough funds to have the flooring in the front entryway replaced which will be scheduled for replacement later this year. Finally, our group is planning a cleanup day in the spring where we and other volunteers will come to the center and repaint/clean up the backlot. In total we have raised more than \$11,000 to fund these projects.

Our group also wanted to provide a long lasting impact for the children at YouthGo so we are developing a mentorship program where we will have local community members come in and give a short presentation to the students, talking about their background and what led them to where they currently are in their professional lives. The goal is to give students the ability to hear from local leaders and see all the paths that are available post high school. This program will begin in fall of 2025, and will be held on a monthly basis and hopefully carry forward for a long time.

GROUP #2 - RE-BIKED: CONNECTING THE COMMUNITY TO TRANSPORTATION

Objective & Outcome

The Re-Biked Project was founded with the vision of establishing a community initiative aimed at empowering individuals in need by providing them with bicycles. Our mission is to enhance mobility, promote sustainable transportation, and improve the quality of life for those who lack access to reliable transportation. In collaboration with the City of Menasha, we repurposed abandoned bicycles, restoring them with the expertise of Menasha High School's small engine class to ensure they were fully functional and ready for use. To support this effort, we actively sought donations from local businesses and personal connections, securing the necessary funds to refurbish bicycles requiring additional care.

Once the bicycles were restored, we partnered with a network of local nonprofit organizations to identify families who would benefit most from this initiative. We then delivered the bicycles to these families, also providing new helmets and locks—funded through remaining donations—to ensure safe and secure transportation. We look forward to the continued collaboration between the City of Menasha, Menasha High School, and local nonprofits, whose members have directly benefited from this program. Through these partnerships, we remain committed to fostering a stronger, more connected, and sustainable community.

GROUP # 3 - SUBURBAN ATHLETICS CONCESSION STAND MODERNIZATION PROJECT

Objective & Outcome

Suburban Athletics (Club) is a Non-Profit organization whose purpose is to provide youth in the Fox Valley a quality softball and baseball program that promotes teamwork, self-esteem, and increase skill knowledge in a safe, non-threatening environment. The club's baseball field, O'Hauser Park, was operating with a very unsafe pavilion/concession stand. The concession stand is the primary revenue generator that allows Suburban Athletics to keep player and team fees as low as possible, so it was crucial for the club to get the stand in better condition. By providing a safe environment for family volunteers, we enable them to watch their children play ball while contributing to the club's revenue. This approach helps maintain the integrity of the club and ensures continued support from the community.

Our small group goal for this project was to assist Suburban Athletics in raising financial and in-kind contributions to improve the concession stand. We are actively raising funds and generating engagement within the community. Although we are unable to begin renovations on the new concession stand until the baseball season concludes, we will continue to raise funds throughout the summer and into the fall, ensuring that we can commence renovations during the off-season.

GROUP #4 - TAKIN' IT OUTSIDE WITH B.A.B.E.S.

Objective & Outcome

B.A.B.E.S., Inc. is a local nonprofit committed to preventing child abuse and neglect by providing free respite care, educational support, and counseling to young families in our community. One of their hallmark programs has been Takin' It Outside, a summer event designed to bring families together for a day of fun, connection, and access to local resources. Due to staffing and volunteer shortages, the event was unable to take place last year.

This year, our group is partnering with B.A.B.E.S., Inc. to help bring the event back to life. The objective of this project is to support the revival and long-term sustainability of Takin' It Outside. Through collaboration with the LFC class, this initiative will provide strategic planning, fundraising, marketing, and volunteer coordination to ensure the event's success. The goal is to create a safe, engaging, and resource-rich experience for B.A.B.E.S. families while welcoming the broader community.

With LFC's support, Takin' It Outside will be held on June 20 at Appleton Memorial Park, featuring games, food trucks, a movie, and nonprofit resources. The event will benefit from increased visibility, stronger community partnerships, and expanded volunteer support. A key outcome of this collaboration will be the development of a streamlined event planning process that the B.A.B.E.S. team can use to sustain the event in future years. LFC classmates will be asked to support the effort by spreading the word, recruiting business sponsors, and most importantly, volunteering on the day of the event.

GROUP #5 - NATIONAL MARROW DONOR PROGRAM PROJECT

Objective & Outcome

The National Marrow Donor Program (NMDP), formerly known as Be The Match, is a global nonprofit leader in cell therapy, dedicated to saving the lives of patients with blood cancers and disorders. By simply providing a cheek swab, individuals aged 18-35 can join the registry, and their samples are sent to NMDP to potentially match patients in need.

Children's Wisconsin hosts a renowned Blood and Marrow Transplant (BMT) and Cellular Therapy Program, having performed over 1,500 transplants for patients with blood cancers such as leukemia and lymphoma, as well as diseases like sickle cell. Notably, 90% of donations involve a non-invasive stem cell collection, while only 10% require the more invasive bone marrow procedure.

By partnering with the National Marrow Donor Program (NMDP), we successfully hosted an event at Lawrence University to raise awareness about the importance of marrow donation. We educated students and staff on how marrow donations can save lives. Over 50 individuals registered with NMDP and had their cheek swabs collected to determine if they are potential matches.

GROUP #6 - NOT ON OUR TURF: TACKLE TRAFFICKING

Objective & Outcome

Human trafficking, as defined by the Department of Justice, is a crime involving the exploitation of a person for labor, services, or commercial sex. Incidents of human trafficking often increase during highly attended, high-profile events. The objective of “Not on Our Turf: Tackle Trafficking” was to partner with Awaken to raise community awareness and support prevention efforts against human trafficking in Wisconsin, with particular focus on the Fox Cities and Brown County areas, especially during the 2025 NFL Draft in Green Bay.

Our team successfully secured sponsorship from local employers to enhance and expand Awaken’s initiatives surrounding the 2025 NFL Draft in Green Bay. We created and distributed branded can koozies, lip balms, and informational posters to educate the community and raise awareness within local service industries. Additionally, we facilitated a proclamation with the City of Neenah which recognized Human Trafficking Awareness Day on January 11th. Through our networks, we also promoted Awaken’s Blue Jean Ball fundraiser, further supporting their mission.
