#### Objective & Outcome

Every child deserves the chance to play. Many face financial barriers that keep them from playing and interacting with their peers simply due to a good pair of shoes. We partnered with the Boys & Girls Clubs of the Fox Valley to help kids put their best foot forward by hosting a youth shoe drive throughout the community during the month of April.

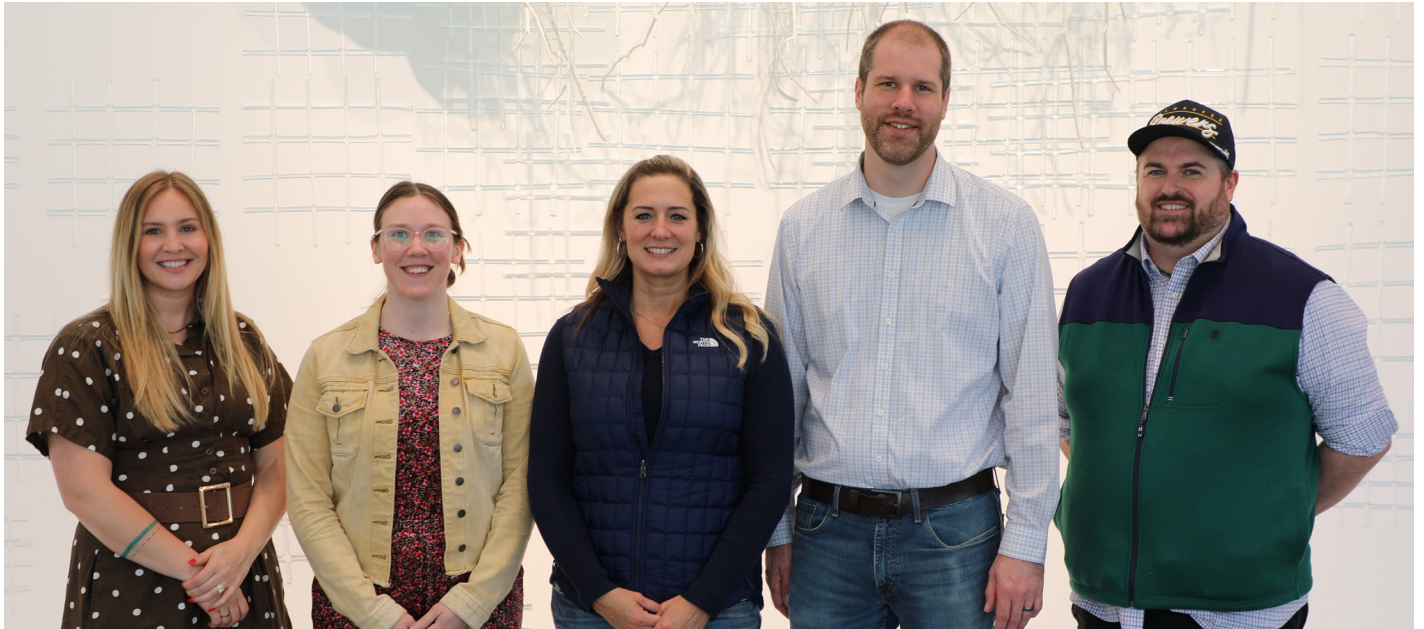
Local business partners like BMO Bank, Iron Forge Fitness + Training, Boys & Girls Club locations and more hosted a donation box to encourage community members to donate new youth shoes. Through a partnership with Midwest Communications, we were able to promote the drive through six radio stations throughout Northeast Wisconsin and host live remotes at the various drop off locations to generate awareness around the campaign.

The right shoes empower kids to:

- Run, jump, climb and move without discomfort.
- Join team activities and group play opportunities.
- Build social skills and make new friends.
- Gain emotional confidence and independence.

Through donated shoes and monetary contributions, we were able to provide the Boys & Girls Clubs of the Fox Valley with a supply of youth shoes to distribute to children in need throughout the Fox Cities helping each child take one more step toward feeling confident, included and supported leading to bigger opportunities and bright futures.

### GROUP # 3 - Build a Bed, Build a Future

#### Objective & Outcome

This initiative was launched to champion the mission of Sleep in Heavenly Peace (SHP) Appleton, a nonprofit dedicated to the belief that a bed is a basic necessity for every child. In the Fox Cities, bed poverty remains a hidden crisis, with hundreds of children sleeping on floors, blankets, or shared sofas. This lack of proper rest directly hinders a child's learning, creativity, and overall well-being, creating a barrier to their success. The project's primary objective was to tackle this issue head-on by setting an ambitious goal to raise \$15,000 and secure in-kind support to fund the construction of 50 beds. The team aimed to foster 'Leadership in Action,' empowering community members to transition from observers into active problem-solvers by working side-by-side to assemble these beds.

The team raised \$10,000 and gathered many in-kind supports that resulted in 53 completed beds, surpassing the initial goal. This success was amplified by significant media engagement, as four local news stations covered the build day, bringing unprecedented advocacy to the issue of bed poverty. The event served as a multigenerational rally point, drawing in more than 40 volunteers ranging from 12-year-olds to those in their senior years, all working side-by-side to ensure 53 local children finally had a place of their own to sleep.

This achievement was made possible through the expert guidance of Chris and Cliff Uitenbroek, the leads at SHP Appleton, and their dedicated volunteers. We were lifted up by our "Dream Building" sponsors, Community First Credit Union and American National Bank, along with the Grand Chute Police Department, which provided the essential home base for the project and many police and fire volunteers. Generous support was also provided by The Stripe Guy, LLC, Front Row Trucks, Greg Peterson, and Kelly Hanink. Beyond the numbers, the project provided a transformative experience; team members and volunteers walked away with a firsthand understanding of how to identify a quiet community need and learned that a leader's true role is to foster an environment where every individual feels they have a personal stake in the solution. This work remains vital, as the Appleton SHP chapter anticipates delivering more than 250 beds to children in the Fox Cities this year alone.

### GROUP #4 - Badger Elementary: Hydroponics for Learning Project

#### Objective & Outcome

Our group is partnering with the Appleton Education and Fork Farms Foundation to address a significant gap in access to fresh, nutritious food for a high-need youth population in the Fox Cities—specifically, students at Badger Elementary School. The community served includes a large percentage of economically disadvantaged families, many of whom experience food insecurity and limited access to healthy food options due to financial hardship, transportation barriers, or housing instability.

Through the installation of a hydroponic growing system, students will be able to grow fresh produce year-round in a safe, controlled indoor environment—regardless of season or weather. By bringing food production directly into the school setting, this initiative removes key barriers to healthy food access while supporting youth wellbeing and food security.

The project's impact begins with nutrition. Access to healthy food during childhood plays a critical role in physical health, focus, academic performance, and the development of lifelong habits. Beyond food access, the Flex Farm creates a hands-on learning environment where students actively engage in growing, caring for, and harvesting food. This real-world experience fosters curiosity, responsibility, teamwork, and a deeper understanding of sustainability and environmental stewardship.

Ultimately, this initiative is more than growing vegetables. It is about growing opportunity—supporting healthy nutritional habits, strengthening student wellbeing, and investing in a healthier, more sustainable future for children, families, and the broader Fox Cities community.

### GROUP #5 - Dear Fox Cities

#### Objective & Outcome

Dear Fox Cities is our community storytelling project created with the intention of promoting intergenerational connection and mental wellness across the Fox Valley. The project was designed to give people of all ages a simple, accessible way to share their experiences, reflections, and hopes all while remaining anonymous.

The idea evolved from an initial pen pal concept into a one-time storytelling initiative that ensured positive participation and broad reach. The team created six postcard prompts focused on personal reflection and community connection, which were translated into English, Spanish, and Hmong. These postcards were distributed through schools, libraries, nursing homes, and community organizations throughout the Fox Valley.

After one month, we the group collected and reviewed more than 600 postcards, capturing voices from multiple generations and backgrounds. The responses ranged from deeply personal stories and beautiful drawings to hopeful messages for the future, highlighting the shared values and experiences that make the Fox Cities feel like home.

The project will be featured in a creative display for the community to read and reflect on the postcards in a temporary public art installation in downtown Appleton—between the downtown U.S. Venture building (the 222 Building) and Copper Rock Coffee—in summer 2026. ### GROUP #6 - Wellness Stations: Supporting Youth Wellness in the Fox Cities

#### Objective & Outcome

Our group project focuses on supporting student mental health by creating Wellness Stations in local middle schools throughout the Fox Cities. Wellness Stations function similarly to Little Free Libraries, providing students with free, discreet access to calming tools and trusted resources during the school day when they need emotional support or a moment to reset.

Mental health challenges often emerge during middle school years, and school counselors play a critical role in supporting students during this time.

The Wellness Stations are designed to reinforce counselors' efforts by normalizing help seeking behavior and making support easily accessible within the school environment. Items included in each station were selected based on counselor and student feedback. We have included positive message cards with QR codes to local mental health resources, calming activity cards, sensory tools, basic school supplies, and personal care items.



Our group secured a \$5,000 donation to fund initial setup and installation, along with a commitment of \$50 per school per month for restocking during the first year. Five area middle schools have agreed to host Wellness Stations, with counselor meetings and student feedback already completed. Those schools include: James Madison Middle School, Einstein Middle School, Wilson/Magellan Middle School, Kaleidoscope Academy, and Little Chute Middle School. Outreach to community partners is ongoing to support long term sustainability, with the goal of creating visible care for invisible struggles and a replicable model for future expansion. Delivery and installation was completed in late April 2026, aligning with the start of Mental Health Awareness Month to reinforce the importance of student wellbeing and access to support.

### GROUP #7 - Weekend Without Worry: Strengthening the St. Joseph's Backpack Food Assistance Program

#### Objective & Outcome

Our group united around a shared goal of addressing childhood food insecurity in the Fox Valley. We partnered with St. Joseph Food Pantry to support its Backpack Food Assistance Program, which provides weekend meals to more than 1,300 students across eight school districts and distributing over 5,000 pounds of food each week.

After learning more about the program's scope and need, we shifted our focus to strengthening its long-term sustainability. We developed a tiered sponsorship model to engage local businesses and create a consistent funding stream, with outreach across multiple Fox Valley communities.

In addition to fundraising efforts, our group volunteered on-site, helping pack 1,800 backpacks in just two hours, providing over a week's worth of meals for local students.

Through this project, we increased awareness, expanded community engagement, and helped build a more sustainable foundation for a program that plays a critical role in supporting children facing food insecurity.
